

Bite-Sized Fair FAQs

1. Is the Bite-Sized Fair the LA County Fair?

No, the Bite-Sized Fair is not the traditional LA County Fair – it is a smaller version on a small footprint, with food, a few carnival rides and some vendors.

2. What happened to the LA County Fair?

The LA County Fair is moving to the month of May starting in 2022.

3. How much is admission to the Bite-Sized Fair?

Admission is \$2 per person when tickets are purchased with parking and bought in advance online. Parking is \$10 in advance, \$15 day of. Ride share passengers and other drop-offs are \$5 for admission. **There is no pedestrian entrance – guests must arrive in their own car, via ride share or vehicle drop-off.**

4. What are the dates/hours of operation?

3 to 9 p.m. Sept. 10-12, 17-19 and 24-26.

5. Can I buy tickets at the gate?

No, we will not be selling tickets at the gate. Tickets must be purchased in advance.

6. Can I rent a wheelchair, scooter or stroller at Bite-Sized Fair?

Since Bite-Sized Fair will have a much smaller footprint than the traditional Fair, we will not have wheelchair, scooter or stroller rentals.

7. What if I accidentally bought tickets for the wrong day?

8. Up to what age do children get in free?

Just like the LA County Fair, children 5 and younger are free.

9. Do I have to wear a mask?

Yes, masks will be mandatory. We are following the guidelines of Los Angeles County. We will not be screening for vaccines nor taking temperatures.

11. Are you selling a season pass for the Bite-Sized Fair?

No, due to the ongoing pandemic, season passes will not be available for the September Bite-Sized Fair Event.

14. Will there be fair competitions?

There will be no competitions at Bite-Sized Fair, but there will be for the LA County Fair in May, 2022. Information will be posted in the future at lacountyfair.com.

15. Where is ride share drop off?

Ride share drop-off is at Gate 17. Follow ride share signs.

16. Are there parking restrictions? Can I come in an RV?

There are no Parking restrictions. There is no overnight parking, however, RVs as well as motorcycles can park for the same rate of \$10 per vehicle per day.

17. Is there parking for disabled patrons?

Yes, there will be designated parking for disabled patrons with a valid handicap parking tag.

18. Are there job opportunities for the Bite-Sized Fair?

We are not holding a job fair for the Bite-Sized Fair.

19. Will my favorite food/commercial vendor be there?

22. Can I buy tickets for the carnival rides in advance?

Yes, you can buy advance tickets with an RCS Fun Pass, available at lacountyfair.com/bite. Fun Passes are \$20 (40 tickets), \$50 (100 tickets) and \$100 (200 tickets) and can be used for rides and games. Rides range from 4 to 16 tickets.
