Official Show Rules

1. This show is held in strict accordance with the latest and revised Official Show Rules of the American Rabbit Breeders Association, Inc. (ARBA)
2. All Rabbits must be permanently marked in the left ear prior to showing. An ARBA licensed Registrar will be available for earmarks as well as ARBA Registrations.
3. EAR CHANGES ONLY – are to be made with the show secretary before the show begins. No other changes are allowed.
4. Exhibitors are responsible to make sure their rabbits are taken to the judging area when called. Absolutely, NO refunds of entry fees will be made.
5. Judges' decisions are final. All complains and protests are to be reported to the show superintendents only and filed according to ARBA rules.
6. Photographing or videotaping is by permission only.
7. Any exhibitor interfering with the judging may be asked to leave the fairgrounds and entry forfeited. According to ARBA rules an exhibitor cannot make any comments which may identify ownership of a rabbit or cavy, nor may they attempt to influence the judging of an animal. Anyone doing so may have their animal disqualified, removed from the show and their entry forfeited.
8. All Rabbits and cavies are entered at the owner's risk. Judges and show committee are not in any way responsible for injuries/death to rabbits and cavies, but every precaution will be taken for their safety. Any animals showing signs of contagious disease will be excused and the owner will remove it immediately from the show fairgrounds.
9. No animals, other than rabbits or cavies are allowed on the fairgrounds.
10. Absolutely NO rabbits under 6 weeks of age allowed on the fairgrounds. If the show committee feels an animal is younger than 6 week, the owner will be asked to remove it from the fairgrounds immediately.
11. No smoking within 50 feet of the show area.
12. Non-exhibitors who offer animals for sale will be asked to leave.
13. KIHRC reserves the right to change or alter these rules. Notification will be printed in the show catalog.
14. Awards must be picked up the day of the show. Legs are mailed within 30 days of the show.
15. All animals must be in proper-sized transport cages to ensure Rabbit's well-being.
16. Parents – Children MUST be under the supervision of the adults at all times.
17. The LAC Fairgrounds, KIHRC and/or its officers are not liable for any injury or damage in connection with the show. '
18. Exhibitors must clean their area when leaving; otherwise, a fine may be imposed.
19. Youth may not enter the same animal in both open and youth shows, but they may enter different animals in open and in youth.
20. Any issue arising that cannot be resolved by reference to the above rules shall be decided by the official show committee, whose decision will be final.
21. Once entry is made the Entry Fee is Due! Even if you are unable to attend, the funds need to be paid. Failure to pay the fees will result in you being banned from KIHRC shows until your balance is paid in full. Late fees may be applied to your balance if an extended time passes. Please remember, we are a non-profit of volunteers.

LOS ANGELES COUNTY FAIRGROUND SPECIFIC RULES

22. LAC Fairgrounds is not responsible for lost, damaged, or stolen items.
23. LAC Fairgrounds is a public venue. Please maintain a professional image and follow proper animal protocol and welfare practices while on or about the fairgrounds.

ARBA Show Rules Section 52 (revised) is effective immediately:

Youth exhibitors may enter sanctioned youth shows from the age of five (on their fifth birthday) through the age 18 (until their nineteenth birthday). An adult cannot show in youth classes at any time. Youth exhibitors must be able to handle their own animals. If stated in the catalog, all youth entries must be carried by youth. Youth exhibitors are not required to carry their own animals to the table.
