DISPLAY POLICY

The LA County Fair reserves the right to limit items for display to the facilities available. All entries will be on display as long as it adheres to the entry rules. The Fair assumes total design control over the presentation of exhibits. The design staff shall determine location and placement of exhibits. No exhibit changes will be made after the items are on display.

All reasonable care will be taken in handling and displaying exhibits, but the LA County Fair assumes no responsibility for loss or damage whatsoever the cause. Submitting an exhibit implies acceptance of this rule. If insurance is desired, the exhibitor must carry it.

AWARDS

- Ribbons will be awarded to 1st, 2nd and 3rd place winners.
- Best of Division Rosette awarded to one first place winner in each division.
- Best of Class Rosette awarded to one first place winner in each class. (Only given if division has multiple classes.)
- These awards are granted at the discretion of the judges.

JUDGING

The Danish System of Judging is used in Home Arts unless otherwise stated. The judging process is based upon established standards of quality for each type of product. In this system, each exhibit is judged according to how well it meets those standards rather than how it compares with the other exhibits. Judges shall avoid unnecessary fraternization with exhibitors. No person shall be allowed, under any circumstances, to interfere with the judge, or judges, during their adjudications, or with the Fair's staff, or to offer any criticism of any exhibit of another. **No judging information will be given by telephone, email or mail. Results will be posted on our website after May 17, 2024.** The judges may award first, second, third place, etc., according to merit. If without merit, the judges shall make no award under any circumstances. This rule applies whether there are one or more exhibits in the class. **The judges decisions shall be final.**

Class 1 - Hand Drawn

- All entries must be securely mounted on either matboard or cardboard, with no more than a 2" border around artwork. Construction paper is OK if it is laminated. No foam core. Canvas and canvas boards do not need to be mounted.
- Maximum size is 11" x 17", not including matting.
- Affix or write your name, age and the orientation you would like the drawing displayed on the back of the matting.

Class 2 - Computer Generated

- All entries must be securely mounted on either matboard or cardboard, with no more than a 2" border around artwork. Construction paper is OK if it is laminated. No foam core. Canvas and canvas boards do not need to be mounted.
- Maximum size is 11" x 17", not including matting.
- Affix or write your name, age and the orientation you would like the drawing displayed on the back of the matting.

- Division includes pencil, color pencil, pen, marker, crayon, charcoal and chalk.
- All entries must be securely mounted on either matboard or cardboard, with no more than a 2" border around artwork. Construction paper is OK if it is laminated. No foam core. Canvas and canvas boards do not need to be mounted.
- Maximum size is 11" x 17", not including matting.
- Affix or write your name, age and the orientation you would like the drawing displayed on the back of the matting.

DECORATIVE PAINTING

Class 1 - Decorative Painting/Tole Art

Tole painting was originally defined as painting on tin. The current, broader definition is called decorative painting, and allows the use of any surface such as wood, glass, porcelain, tin, stoneware, canvas, etc. It is an adverse art form wherein it is an expression of color, subject matter and craftsmanship.

Class 2 - Realistic

Oil, acrylic or Tempera – Realistic Art is a style that represents things as they really are. This type is a rendering of the precise details of things, scenes or florals.

Class 3 - Whimsical

Oil, acrylic or Tempera - Fun, cute, stylized or character pieces that don't fit any other classes.

Class 4 - Water Color

Water color will be judged on appearance, difficulty and originality only.

Class 5 - Other

RULES

- All entries must be securely mounted on either matboard or cardboard, with no more than a 2" border around artwork. Construction paper is OK if it is laminated. No foam core. Canvas and canvas boards do not need to be mounted.
- Picture frames are accepted.
- Maximum size is 11" x 17", not including matting.
- Affix or write your name, age and the orientation you would like the painting displayed on the back of the matting.

YOUTH DIVISION ENTRY RULES

1. Exhibitors are responsible for reading the competition information, individual rules for each competition, general entry rules, and must abide by them.
2. Please print out your online entry receipt for your records.
3. You must be between 5 and 17 years of age to enter. If exhibitors are 18 years of age and older and would like to enter their projects at the fair, visit www.lacountyfair.com/competitions for information on Home Arts Adult Competitions.
4. Entries accepted from INDIVIDUALS ONLY, unless otherwise stated.
5. Entry must be made under the name of the individual whose exhibit it is. Your entry tag will reflect this. No fictitious names. **Parent/Guardian please make sure you register with your child's first and last name and not a parent/guardian name.**
6. All entries entered must be the handiwork of the exhibitor. If, in the opinion of the Fair staff, an item had previously been entered, the Fair reserves the right to withhold the item from judging and display. Items can only be entered in the LA County Fair once.
7. One item per entry line.
8. Under description enter a basic brief description of the item. For example, "yellow flowers"
9. In classes calling for "any, specify" or "other than listed, specify" be sure to indicate on the entry form the type of item being entered.
10. Only items listed and described on the entry form will be accepted for judging.
11. Judges and/or Fair staff may reassign entries to a more appropriate division and/or class.
12. Delivery of all entries is on Saturday, March 2, 2024 from 9:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m. only. If you are unable to drop off your entry at this time you may send someone in your place or mail your item. All mailed entries must arrive by 4:00 p.m. on Thursday, February 29, 2024 and include a copy of your online entry receipt.
13. Fairplex will not be responsible for returning display hardware i.e. hangers, etc.
14. Entries that are stained, soiled or showing obvious signs of wear or use will be disqualified. Entries must be finished and no incomplete work will be accepted. Fair reserves the right to reject any exhibit or entry, if there is anything questionable, unsuitable, obscene, or requires more space than can be given, or conflicts with exhibit requirements.
15. **All entries must not exceed 25 pounds, have sturdy hardware and be ready to hang. Items designed for hanging that are not so equipped will be displayed in a manner deemed appropriate by the Fair. If you have an entry that is large in scale, please contact the Competition Coordinator to verify we can accept the entry.**
16. **No fresh flowers or food permitted as an entry. Only artificial flowers or food can be used with the exception of dried flowers.**
17. Identification tags will be issued for all items entered and exhibitors will be given a claim check for each item.
18. **Each entry must have your name displayed on the back of the entry. If the entry needs to be displayed a certain way, please indicate that next to your name.**



YOUTH DIVISION ENTRY RULES

19. Although reasonable efforts are taken to safeguard the exhibitor's property against loss, damage, or theft, neither the Fairplex nor the LA County Fair are responsible for any loss, damage or theft of exhibitor's property brought on the premises during the period of the LA County Fair. Every precaution will be taken in the handling and exhibiting of entries.
20. Pick up of all entries is on Tuesday, June 4, 2024 from 10:00 a.m. to 7:00 p.m. only. Bring your claim checks with you. If your claim checks are lost, you must show photo identification before we release your items. If you are unable to pick up your items, you must send someone in your place. Please send them with your claim checks. **If they do not have your claim checks, you must either call or email our office by 4:00pm Monday, June 3 so we can put them on the item pick up list.** The person picking up your items must have photo identification. If entries are not picked up then they will be donated to charity.
21. No person shall sign the entry form as an agent at the LA County Fair in any department if they are a manager, director, association member, department head, or paid employee.
22. The Los Angeles County Fair Association reserves the right to amend and add to these rules and empowers the Executive Committee with the final and absolute right to interpret all rules and regulations and arbitrarily settle and determine all matters, questions and differences in regard thereto.
23. **MAIL RETURN INFORMATION:**
 - a. Exhibitors who send items to the Fair and wish to have them returned by mail must enclose a check for \$25.00 with their entry form and indicate that it is for a mail return.
 - b. Items will be returned by June 30, 2024.
 - c. Breakable, fragile or extremely heavy items will NOT be returned by mail; such items MUST be picked up.
 - d. Size of the item must not exceed 130 inches in length and girth combined.
 - e. Proper packaging materials MUST accompany all items that are to be shipped back.
