



**2025 LA COUNTY FAIR NEW FOOD & BEVERAGE GENERAL INFORMATION
APPLICATION DEADLINE FEBRUARY 7, 2025**

The LA County Fair puts the spotlight on all things creative in 2025 with its theme “Art Unleashed.”

The Fair has been a celebration of art for more than a century: home arts, culinary arts, visual arts, performing arts, fine arts. The art of having fun. The art of making memories. Celebrate artistry and mastery in all their diverse forms with the Fair’s immersive experience that promises to captivate all guest.

LA County Fair Schedule: May 2, 2025 – May 26, 2025 (open on Memoria Day)
Operating Hours: Opening Day Hours: Friday, May 2, 2025 – 5 p.m. to 11p.m.
Regular Days: Thursday through Sunday & Memorial Day – 11 a.m. to 11p.m.

Closed on Mondays - Wednesdays with the exception of Memoria Day.

Application deadlines are as follows:

February 7, 2025 **(\$50 processing fee due if accepted to participate in the 2025 Fair)**

All Food & Beverage locations are subject to availability. **Incomplete applications will not be accepted.**

Decisions to contract for Food & Beverage shall be at the sole discretion of OVG Hospitality and the Los Angeles County Fair Association. All applications will receive consideration.

1. Each subcontractor must have approved POS. **Square will not be accepted.**
2. Each subcontractor must be prepared to accept credit cards
3. Rent percentages 29% to 34% depending on location
4. List menu items with sales NOT tax included – **Menu due with Application**
5. Photos of mobile stand, tent or food truck- **Photos due with Application**
6. OVG Hospitality will collect sales tax (10.25%) sales tax will be paid under OVG Hospitality permit number
7. OVG Hospitality and the Los County Fair Association will set soda/water pricing

Deposits due at signing of contract:

- \$2,500.00

Location Includes:

- Basic electricity – 220v 70amps
- Water
- Sewer
- Staff admission and parking passes

Additional Charges:

- LA County Health Permit - \$184.00
- Fairplex Internet, Form with pricing will be provided with Contract
- Electricity over 220v-70amps

Employee Background Checks:

Fairplex has ask that all Subcontractors do a background check on all employees. Background should include Megan's Law and any other reasonable background check that may be required by the Los Angeles County Fair Association. Signed Megan's Law Form listing all employees will be required if accepted to participate in the Fair. Form will be provided with Contract. **Due with Signed Contract if accepted to participate in the LA County Fair.**

Insurance: Due with Signed Contract if accepted to participate in the LA County Fair.

At time of signed contract Subcontract shall provide Oak View Group Food Service and Hospitality with **Original Certificate of General Liability Insurance Policy.**

General Liability in the amount of \$1,000,000

Personal Property in the amount of \$1,000,000

Certificate Holder:

Oak View Group (OVG Hospitality) and LA County Fair Association.

Additional Insured:

The policy shall name The City of Pomona, Fairplex, The County of Los Angeles, The Los Angeles County Fair Association, Oak View Group (OVG Hospitality), and all owed or related entities, its offices, directors, employees, customers, distributors, suppliers, and agents.

Worker's Compensation Insurance Certificate: Every subcontractor shall maintain worker's compensation insurance for all of its employees working at the Fair or on Fair property as required by California law. A certificate of said insurance must be kept in file with the Oak View Group. If you do not require or are exempt from carrying worker's compensation insurance under California law, you must file a letter with proof of such exemption with the Oak View Group as required above in place of the certificate of insurance, but you must obtain such insurance if the basis for its exemption subsequently is no longer applicable. - **Serve Safe Certificate:** A copy of ServSafe Certificate will be required if accepted to participate in the Fair. **Due with Signed Contract if accepted to participate in the LA County Fair.**
- **Food Handler:** All Employee are required to have valid Food Handler's Card. **Due with Signed Contract if accepted to participate in the LA County Fair.**
- **LA County Health Permit:** Every seller is required to have a temporary health permit. Permits will be issued through Oak View Group. Health Permit applications will be sent with Contract.
