KCHUNG Public founder and KCHUNG President & CEO, **christy roberts berkowitz**, (whose name includes her maternal family's surname and is intentionally presented in lowercase) is a multidisciplinary artist, writer, curator, musician and DJ from the Los Angeles area in her second year as [Creative Strategist](#) for Los Angeles County. Having DJed vinyl at East LA house parties since high school, christy's open form groove driven DJ sets celebrate culturally rooted music, expanded under the tutelage of longtime collaborator, Grammy®-winning DJ and Scratch Academy professor Jahi Sundance. christy's sets have been featured by the Jepson Center, the Chrysler Museum, Dashboard, Los Angeles Road Concerts, MOCA, and The Music Center with the legendary Art Laboe, among many more.

roberts berkowitz's multidisciplinary conceptually guided work has been hosted and/or commissioned by MOCA Los Angeles, the Getty Museum, the Telfair Museum, the Chrysler Museum, the Hammer Museum, the Los Angeles County Museum of Art, Bader and Simon, MIT Press, among many others. She released her debut album "WOLVES," under the name "christy" in August 2022 on Alpha Pup Records.

Rocio "Wyldeflower" Contreras is an on-air radio host and DJ at 89.9 KCRW and dublab, as well as a music supervisor and creative producer. Ro is from Pasadena, California, and has decades of experience in art, festival, and concert production and programming. Inspired by discovery, she constantly explores new and classic music from around the globe, with a special dedication to tropicalia, MPB, soul, funk, jazz, as well as artists that transcend genre. Catch her on-air and in-person, where she draws from her deep collection of sounds to craft a unique sonic experience each time she steps behind the turntables.

Curating a "Movement of Sound", LA native, **Jeli Daniel**, founder of Red Light Vinyl, "RLV" began as a local start up collective of female vinyl enthusiasts, record collectors, and selectors, originally spinning 33 and 45s. RLV evolved into supporting and working with upcoming local establishments, being heavily immersed in Los Angeles Art World, LA LGBTQI Community, a musical voice for Femme DJs on the uprise, and local nonprofit organizations such as S.P.Y, A Safe Place for Home, (space for youth for homeless), and female driven business and startups!

R&D: Desearch & Revelopment are DJ duo Ray.Only and Dean Buckley: As promoters and selectors they set the ambience for several events at Precinct DTLA nightclub: They deliver goth, synthwave, and industrial music for the eerie monthly event She's in Parties; host Bearded Pig Disco with dance floor stompers from all eras; and empower queer culture-focused Homo Megamix. In addition, the duo turns back time with their '80s dance party Tainted Love Shack; and fill late-night warehouses co-producing the Beefcake party. Dean and Ray are members of The Sound Lab collective and provide regular radio show programming for KCHUNG (1630 AM Chinatown) via their residency at MOCA's Geffen Contemporary.
